Hello all,

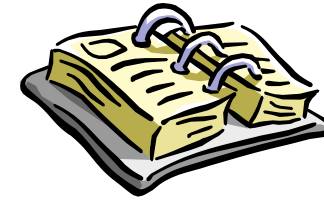
